2024 Trunk-or-Treat Rules

Saturday, October 5, 2023

10:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

1. The event will be held at the Midlothian Park District, 14500 S. Kostner Avenue.
2. All treats must be individually wrapped. By submitting a participation form, the trunk owner acknowledges that all treats are subject to inspection.
3. Vehicle must arrive at the Midlothian Park District parking lot on October 5th **no later than 9:15 a.m.**
4. All trunks must be decorated and staffed by 9:55 a.m. – the event begins at 10:00 a.m.
5. Electrical support will not be available.
6. All trunk registrations must be submitted to Midlothian Park District by **Monday, September 30, 2024.**
7. Only those who have properly registered their vehicles by Monday, September 30, 2024 will be allowed to participate at this event.
8. No chairs or tables will be provided by The Midlothian Park District.
9. **Registered vehicles must stay at the event until the event ends at 12:30 pm. For safety purposes, registered vehicles will not be allowed to leave the parking lot until the event is over, this includes leaving to get more candy.**
10. Vehicle must be attended by an adult at all times.
11. Participants should be aware that children of all ages are expected to attend this event.
12. Businesses and organizations are allowed a single banner or sign advertising their business or service.
13. No alcoholic beverages are permitted.
14. Cars must be turned off for the duration of the event.
15. No open flames, fireworks, flammable liquids, etc.
16. All decorations must be contained within your own parking space.
17. Parking spaces are on a first come basis.
18. One spot equals one vehicle.
19. This is a family-oriented event. Themes must be appropriate for all ages.
