



Seasonal Maintenance Worker Job Description

Under the supervision of the Superintendent of Maintenance, the Seasonal Maintenance Worker will be responsible for general maintenance, cleaning and landscaping in the parks and facilities of the Midlothian Park District. This is a seasonal position from April through September.

Qualifications

- Minimum of 18 years old
- Must have sufficient strength to perform heavy manual labor when required
- Able to work evenings and weekends if assigned
- Willing to learn new tasks and take responsibility for equipment and completion of assigned work
- Accepts responsibility to be punctual and has good attendance

Duties and Responsibilities

- Clean restrooms and facilities
- Remove all garbage from parks, playgrounds and buildings and haul to designated dumpster
- Perform set-up and clean up duties as assigned
- Clean, wash, and lubricate all maintenance equipment after use
- Communicate matters of interest or importance to their supervisor
- Must perform assigned tasks in a safe manor and follow safety policies and procedures
- Perform other duties as assigned

Psychological Considerations

- May experience stress while trying to please the public and the staff

Physiological Considerations

- May be necessary to lift up to 50 pounds
- May be necessary to work in extreme weather conditions
- May be necessary to work long hours

Environmental Considerations:

- May be exposed to varying weather conditions
- May be exposed to bee stings and other insect bites

Cognitive and Safety Considerations:

- Must show safety awareness and good judgment
- Must exhibit good problem-solving ability, be flexible, organized, and use good judgment
