In addition, all future registration fees must be paid by cash, certified check, or money order. We also accept credit cards.

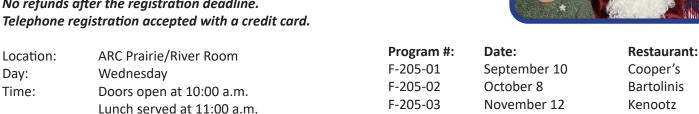
